Guidelines to Graduate Scholarships(Approved November 21, 2024)

Purpose: Must be admitted to a Master's or Doctoral Degree program with the goal of teaching or administration at the secondary or college level with preference given to those whose teaching field major is in short supply (as verified by the Dean of the College of Education).

Minimum Criteria:

- 1) Available to Graduate students.
- 2) A Minimum 3.0 GPA overall.
- 3) Post-baccalaureate Degree objective.
- 4) Master's or Doctoral Program.
- 5) Planning to teach or administration at the secondary or college level.
- 6) A minimum of 12 resident units completed at CSU Stanislaus.
- 7) Recommendation letters from major advisor and department head
- 8) Full-time enrollment preferred.
- 9) Preference among otherwise qualified applicants will be given to students with a financial need.
